- Must serve on the New Student Advisory Committee for first-year
- Selection will be based on extracurricular involvement/leadership, community service, awards, academics and the application essay

- Deadline: March 31st

**PHI THETA KAPPA**

Award Amount: \$2000/year(\$1000 per semester); 15 annual scholarships awarded

- Must be a member of PHI THETA KAPPA
  - Must apply and be admitted by application deadline
  - Have a cumulative GPA of at least a 3.0 or higher on all college level work
  - Selection will be based primarily on cumulative GPA and essays
  - Scholarship is renewable for one year if student completes 12 semester hours (fall and spring) and receives a 3.0 cumulative GPA

  - Submit Copy of PTK certificate
