Dear Rowdy,

You recently withdrew from the University and we are writing to update you on how your withdrawal from UTSA impacts the financial aid you have received for this semester. Federal law governs how the University must determine the amount of financial aid that you are entitled to receive if you withdraw from school

The law requires that when you withdraw during a semester the amount of financial aid that you have earned up to that point is determined by a specific formula. If you received more assistance than you earned, the excess funds must be returned. The University may also be required to refund the U.S. Department of Education some of the financial aid funds that were used to pay for your tuition and fees.

The amount of assistance that you have earned is determined on a pro-rata basis. That is, if you completed 30 percent of the semester, you earn 30 percent of the assistance you were originally scheduled to receive. If you received excess funds that must be returned, you must repay any grant assistance you have received.

If you do not repay these funds by this date the University is required to refer the repayment obligation to the U.S. Department of Education. The Department of Education will contact you regarding the repayment of this obligation. In most cases when you owe an overpayment on financial aid funds received, and have not repaid it or made satisfactory arrangements, you become ineligible to receive other Federal student financial aid until this obligation is repaid.
