COLLEGE OF ARCHITECTURE/USAA FOUNDATION GENERAL SCHOLARSHIP

Undergraduate

Award: five or more awards up to \$500 a year

- Must be a declared major in architecture or interior design

Graduate

Award: five or more awards up to \$1000 a year

- Must be accepted or enrolled in the Master of Architecture program

AIA/SAN ANTONIO CHAPTER SCHOLARSHIP

Award: one award of \$1000 a year (\$500 per semester)

- Must be a junior or senior architecture student
- Must have a minimum 3.0 GPA (grade point average)

BILL AND DIANE HAYS SCHOLARSHIP IN ARCHITECTURE AND INTERIOR DESIGN

Award: one award of \$500 a year

- Must be a full time undergraduate student majoring in architecture or interior design, portfolio and letter of recommendation
- Must have a minimum of 3.0 GPA (grade point average)

DONALD E. EVERETT SCHOLARSHIP IN HISTORICAL PRESERVATION

Award: 3 awards of \$500 per academic year

- Must be admitted or enrolled full-time in the master's program in historical preservation

GENE GEORGE ENDOWED ARCHITECTURE SCHOLARSHIP IN HISTORIC PRESERVATION

Award: one award up to \$1000

- Must be a graduate student in the College of Architecture, who is specializing in Historic Preservation
- Must have a minimum of 3.0 GPA (grade point average)

ELEANOR FREEBORN EDUCATIONAL SCHOLARSHIP

Awards: two \$2,500 scholarships

- Applicants must be Master of Architecture students in the Historical Preservation concentration
- Must be enrolled on a full-time basis (at least 9 credit hours)
- Scholarship will be awarded on merit and demonstrated knowledge

ELEANOR FREEBORN STUDY ABROAD SCHOLARSHIP

Awards: One \$2,500 scholarship

- Applicant must be a Master of Architecture student
- Must be enrolled on a full-time basis (at least 9 credit hours)
- Must enroll in the UTSA Study Abroad Program at the Santa Chiara campus in Castiglion, Fiorentino, Italy.

JACK GREENE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP FOR INTERIOR DESIGN STUDENTS NOT AVAILABLE THIS YEAR.

- **JOHN R. McGIFFERT SCHOLARSHIP (The Society for the Preservation of Historical Ft. Sam Houston)**
Award: one graduate award of \$1500 a year
 - Shall be provided to graduate students enrolled in and pursuing a degree in the College of Architecture at UTSA
 - Must have successfully completed ARC 5233, Architecture Survey and Measured Drawings, with course assignments pertaining to the historic preservation of Fort Sam Houston, San Antonio, Texas

- **LLOYD W. JARY SCHOLARSHIP**
Award: two awards of \$500, one awarded for fall semester and one awarded for spring semester
 - Must have declared a major in architecture or interior design

- **RINALDO J. GONZALEZ AND ALICIA C. TREVINO ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP IN ARCHITECTURE**
Award: Number of amount of wards vary
 - Enrolled full-time graduate student (minimum of 9 credit hours)
 - Actively pursuing a masters degree with a major in Architecture
 - Minimum of 3.0 cumulative grade point average

- **SAN ANTONIO MASONRY CONTRACTORS ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIPS**
Award: one undergraduate award of \$500 a year
 - Must be enrolled for a minimum of 9 hours
 - Must have declared a major in architecture or interior design

SCHOLARSHIPS MANAGED THROUGH THE OFFICE OF THE DEAN

Scholarships listed below have their own application form and require separate portfolios for each entry. Application forms may be obtained from the Dean's Office, as they are available.

AIA/AAF COMPETITIVE SCHOLARSHIPS

Scholarships offered nationally on an annual basis to architecture students. The number of awards varies each year and the scholarship amounts usually range from \$500 to \$3000. Scholarship Requirements and Applications are available through the College of Architecture Dean's Office.

TSA/TAF COMPETITIVE SCHOLARSHIPS

Various scholarships offered nationally yearly on an annual or rotating basis to architecture students. Applications are available through the College of Architecture Dean's Office. Each scholarship has its own requirements, but most scholarships require letters of recommendation, career and goal statement, and a portfolio.
