




Arizona State University Enrollment

Arizona State University Under-represented Minority Enrollment by Ethnicity




Percent of Full-time, First-time Degree-seeking Undergraduates who were awarded Title IV Federal Student Aid by Income Level







Arizona State University One-year Retention Rates








Arizona State University Doctoral Degrees Awarded




Arizona State University Six-Year Graduation Rates By Ethnicity










Arizona State University Headcount by Tenure Status




Arizona State University Percent of Faculty by Tenure Status






Arizona State University Under-represented Minority by Faculty Status



Arizona State University Faculty by Gender




Arizona State University Female Faculty by Tenure Status



Arizona State Student-to-Faculty Ratio





Arizona State University Staff by Ethnicity




Arizona State University Staff by Gender





Arizona State University Total Research Expenditures




Arizona State University Federally Financed Research Expenditures






Arizona State University Total Revenue per FTE Student




Arizona State University Tuition and fees per FTE Student




Arizona State University State Appropriations per FTE Student



Arizona State University Expense Type as a Percent of Core Expenses




Arizona State University Administrative Cost as a Percent of Instructional Cost
