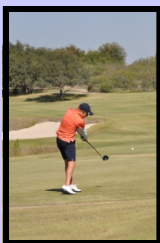
Fabiola Arriaga wins the 2011 Alamo Invitational with a 3 day total of 3 under par.

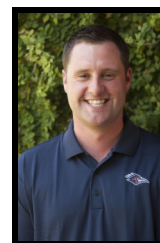
Ian Parnaby and Allie Jordan promoted to new positions on UTSA coaching staff!

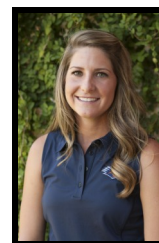
This move led to the creation of a new position for Bill Rogers. Coach Rogers is now the
