- Do we plan to share information about Staff Senate at tabling? Yes, there is a banner. Will work with Communications to share a flyer with information about scholarship etc.

Elections

Cindy Orth – 10 minutes

- Representation. Goal was to analyze total number of eligible employees. There's about 2250 eligible staff members. Communications committee looked at proportionality and the committee has a proposal to increase the number of members from 7 to 8 in A&P. We used to have 8 members in A&P but that was decreased a few years ago. The bylaws would have to be amended to reflect the change.
- Discussion
 - Can the relevant sections of the By-Laws be written flexibly in regards to membership totals/portions so that we wouldn't have to actually update the By-Laws every single time we need to change membership numbers?
 - Found an error of representation numbers: There are 3 instead in president group and 2 in research and 3 in tech.
 - Suggestion is to add 2 more members for A&P. Then the ratio would be 1:59 for A&P, and the total number of Senators would be 42.
 - A&P is at large rather than considering their divisions.
 - What happens if we can't fill all of the positions within an area? Reach out but generally met the number. The number of nominations are increasing each year.
 - Is there a standard ratio in our bylaws? Not there but can be in the bylaws but would require an amendment to create a ratio or ratio range.
 - Harshan, as chair of bylaws committee, will work with the elections committee to talk about potential bylaws updates.
 - Standardizing the ratio and thinking about the maximum ratio, like 1:60 as a maximum.
 If it grows higher, then we'd add another person. It could be lower but never cross a threshold.
 - Does there need to be a minimum?
 - Historically, when you start to combine groups together, those areas are a mash up of unrelated areas often, which doesn't allow for representation of each of the areas.
 - There's an annual audit for each elections cycle.
- We'll come back in April with a proposal based on our discussion
- June 10 nominations process will begin

 - Sneak peek at the Little Runner, downtown campus shuttle. Addressed Brennan Ave. closure – there are plans to reopen late March or by mid-April. Continuing to review parking ticket appeals.

- Public Safety Advisory Council Xavier

- Strategic Investment Fund Committee Damaris
- Sustainability Council Julie
 - o STARS Report
 - Should be published by the end of March
 - Currently on track to earn gold
 - SB17 negatively impacted score on equity and diversity
 - Increased academic programs focused on sustainability positively impacted the score
 - Earth Day Fair 4/22 @ 11:30 AM (location TBD)
 - Hosted by SGA
 - Focus is on recycling and composting on campus
 - Office of Sustainability will be participating as well as other campus partners
 - o Campus Waste
 - Office of Sustainability is looking for better ways to track waste through AI
 - Hazardous and lab waste is tracked by mandate, but solid waste,
 - construction/renovation waste, and surplus waste need better options
 - The Office hopes to reuse surplus locally
 - Currently working on an EPA grant that will hopefully allow UTSA to build a facility
 - Recycling
 - There is currently a significant amount of contamination in recycling (trash and food)
 - The Office hopes to work on educating the campus
 - Trash and Recycling Cans
 - The Office is going to purchase a pilot program that digitally tracks and levels trash and recycling cans
 - The software alerts when the can is full and needs to be emptied
 - It also reports on the area of campus and how often it is full
 - The pilot is about \$2400

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- If the pilot is successful, the full program is about \$5000 annually per building
- Habitat Conservation Plan
 - UTSA houses 2 endangered species on east campus a beetle and a spider
 - UTSA is working with Texas Parks & Wildlife to reserve about 50 acres indefinitely to protect the species
 - Biologists are currently in field studying how to best reserve the land
- o Other Updates
 - Consultant coming this month for a greenhouse gas report
 - UTSA's goal is a 20% reduction in greenhouse gas by 2030 and net zero by 2050
 - UTSA is targeting LEED silver status for any new buildings costing \$10 million and above
 - Bike program has moved to a new building
 - TXDoT grant money will be used to create a hike and bike track on campus
 - Another grant is allowing the purchase of 14 electric vehicles <u>https://www.utsa.edu/campusservices/runner/little-runner.html</u>
 - UTSA will hire an Executive Director of Energy this year

- QIC Lauren H. and Bev
 - Met on Friday, March 1.
 - Salary transparency and career ladders Andrea and Lisa J. were doing investigations.
 Compensation review process is beginning with an outside consulting agency. It'll be a comprehensive compensation review to address salaries and career ladders. It will be an extensive process so we won't have answers right away.
 - Continuing to discuss ways to share about staff retiree benefits. The benefits team created a milestone report within COS. Exploring doing that for other groups. Bev was going to reach out to the STARS committee about retiree recognition.
 - Electric vehicle charging QIC was submitted forwarded to Ricardo for inclusion in the last parking meeting. They are only in the garage so far, so you have to pay for a garage permit or hourly rate, and charged for the charging. They would be looking at peer institutions to see how they handle EV charging. Lauren will bring this up with Ricardo.
 - Where is the nearest EV charging station to UTSA? Perhaps we can find the nearest locations off campus and provide that as a courtesy on our QIC update spreadsheet until Parking can get it together.
 - There isn't a forum for staff to ask questions A QIC was submitted for hosting an online space for tech questions for Outlook, Excel, etc. Maybe adding DYK section about the Viva Engage app or utilizing Teams.

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- Who would manage/moderate that platform?
- Another thing is where you can find tech skills training or where to access training for those.
- STARS Sharon and Pebby
 - \circ STAR nomination process is open right now so the committee is reviewing those.
 - Sharon met with Diane to change the memorandum to change the essay. Sharon is initiating that process. It'll need to end up at Karl Miller-Lugo.
 - For the last year, only two applied, so those amounts were higher than usual. They see mostly grad students applying. The new essay wouldn't be introduced until next year. Sharon asked about increasing the amount, which we could do sooner. There may need to be changes to the rubric that the committee uses.
 - Maybe look into 4 awards rather than 2 for undergrad and 2 for grad, so that'd it open it up to more who are graduate students or to allow for shifting if there are no/few undergrad applications to allow for more flexibility. Changing the description may be important for compliance as well and to prevent confusion.
 - The intent is to request the spreadsheet of awardees for our records. This will help with the Finance committee reconciling the cost center.
